WHAT IT IS AND WHY IT'S USED

➔ **Spay-abortions are performed when a pregnant cat or dog enters a shelter or TNR program**

- It is a routine spay surgery that also ends the pregnancy. The fetuses pass peacefully and pain-free under anesthesia

➔ **Spay-abort prevents suffering and overpopulation. It is a necessary tool, not something we want to do**

- 75% of outdoor kittens die from predators or heLa
- Overcrowded shelters don't need more puppies, millions of dogs are already euthanized each year
- Pregnant animals are at risk of complications

➔ **Help reduce the need for these procedures**

- Spay and neuter your pets
- Support TNR programs
